



The history of fire lookouts on the Kootenai dates to 1930 when the first lookout platform and cabin were built on Star (Square) Peak; the cabin still stands today. In addition to work at Star Peak this summer, NWMLA volunteers will be working on Meadow Peak, Mount Worn, McGuire Mountain, Big Creek Baldy, Zeligler Mountain, Mount Henry, Lost Horse, and Stahl Peak lookouts. As part of these efforts, the NWMLA enjoys working closely with the four Kootenai National Forest Ranger Districts to bring life back to these iconic structures.
