





This year we celebrate McGuire Mountain Lookout's 100-year anniversary. Restoration efforts at McGuire Lookout have taken place over the last few years and it is in the recreation.gov rental program. This summer's NMLA projects include work on Star Peak, Mount Wam, Stahl Peak, NW Peak, Big Creek Baldy, and McGuire lookouts. As part of these efforts, the NMLA enjoys working closely with the four Kootenai National Forest Ranger Districts to bring life back to these iconic structures. The history of fire lookouts on the Kootenai dates to 1910 when the first lookout platform and cabin were built on Star (Squaw) Peak; the original cabin still stands today.
